 - An official letter from your university which details your course of studies until now (including grades, ECTS points, and how far along you are in the completion of your final thesis)
3. If the focus of your studies is not immediately obvious from your transcript of records, please include further documentation
4. Two letters of recommendation from academic teaching staff (in German or English)
5. A letter of motivation, which states reasons for seeking acceptance to the master's program (in German or English)
6. Proof of successful completion of an English language examination (usually IELTS or TOEFL; language skills in English must correspond to at least the C1 level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages)
7. An English-language essay (ca. 2,500 words) on a subject of the applicant's choice, which relates to one of the "English Literatures and Literary Theory" modules.

¹ Official documents which are not in German must be accompanied by official translations.

² If the final documents (transcript of records, certificate and results) are not yet available, the applicant has to provide an official letter from their university stating the successful completion (including final grade) of the degree program.
