

Abbreviations

AGR	Agreement awry (e.g. plural verb and singular noun)
ART	Article missing, wrong article
ASP	Aspect wrong (progressive e.g.)
COLL	Colloquialism, use more refined diction
CONC	Concordance wrong, e.g. sequence of tenses not obeyed
CSTR	Construction awry
GERM	Germanism
LEX	Lexical error. wrong lexeme
ORTH	Orthography/spelling mistake
PCT	Punctuation error.

Note:

no commas between subject and verb phrase or between verb and complement/object NP
no commas in defining relative clauses

use either British or American punctuation rules in consistent fashion!

American style: xxxxxxxx."FN xxxxxxxx," but: xxxxxxxxFN: xxxxxxxFN;

British style: xxxxxxxx".FN
