


#### LIBRARIES REOPENED: University Library and Verbundbibliothek in KG IV

Despite contact restrictions, the book club **Indigenous Reads**, your colloquium dedicated to contemporary indigenous literature, will meet for an online reading of Jesse Thistle's **From the Ashes**, followed by a discussion with the author! The event was organized in cooperation with the Carl Schurz Haus library and will take place via Zoom.



In his debut memoir From the Ashes, Métis-Cree writer Jesse, once a high school dropout and now an Assistant Professor in Métis studies at York University in Toronto, chronicles his life on the streets and how he overcame trauma and addiction to discover the truth about who he is.
